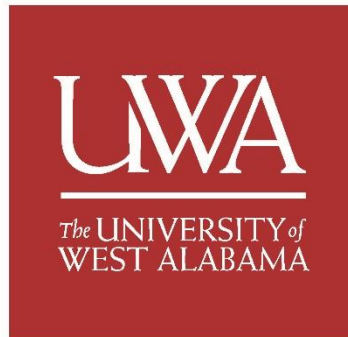

The University of West Alabama (UWA) will host two 2019 Career Exploration Summer Camps (CESC) for students who will be sophomores and juniors during the 2019-2020 school year. The camps will be held on **June 16-21** and **June 23-28, 2019**. Students will be asked to list their first and second preference for camp attendance. If selected, student preference will be taken into consideration for assignments.

The CESC is a residential program where students will stay on the UWA campus. The purpose of the CESC Program is to offer students the ability to explore career options and prepare for college through interactive and engaging hands-on activities, field trips and presentations. The CESC Program, sponsored by the Daniel Foundation of Alabama, is open to students attending public and private secondary schools across the State. The CESC is an extremely intense and structured learning opportunity for youth in the secondary school systems of Alabama.

The curriculum offers students a thorough look into current and emerging career fields, highlights of the knowledge and skills needed for each career, essential information on projected employment—where the jobs are and will continue to grow, and steps that students can take now, while in high school, to prepare for the future. In addition, students will participate in standardized applicant test preparation courses, business etiquette training, team-building activities, academic enhancement activities, career-focused field trips, resume writing, interviewing practice and financial literacy training.

Approximately 20 students from grades 10-11 will be accepted to participate in each week camp. Acceptance into the summer program will cover participants' cost including the following:

- ◆ All program costs/room fees
- ◆ Workshops/Handouts
- ◆ Room and Board
- ◆ Facility Usage
- ◆ Equipment/Supplies
- ◆ Travel (Field Trips)
- ◆ Lab Fees
- ◆ Speakers

The attached application form is being sent to public and private secondary schools across the Black Belt. The CESC is a competitive selection process program limited to 10 male and 10 female students for each camp (for a total of 40) in Choctaw, Greene, Hale, Marengo, Perry, Pickens and Sumter counties. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Parents are encouraged to participate in the application process. Guidance counselors may identify applicants to the CESC Program and assist them with completing the forms in the enclosed application package.

2019 Career Exploration Summer Camp Application Checklist

The 2019 Career Exploration Summer Camp program application deadline date is Monday, February 12. Application packets must be postmarked or delivered to Kelly Land Hall on the UWA campus in Livingston by Monday, February 25. Award recipients will be notified by Friday, March 22. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The following criteria will be used in the selection of scholarship recipients.

Students must:

- ◆ Be in the 10th or 11th grade for the 2019-2020 school year.
- ◆ Have completed or be qualified to enroll in Pre-Algebra for the 2019-2020 school year.
- ◆ Have a cumulative grade point average 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- ◆ Provide one letter of recommendation (i.e. principal, employer, teacher, counselor, community leader) **not a relative**
- ◆ Provide official school transcripts from school principal with school seal.
- ◆ Provide a typed one-page essay explaining why they want to participate in the program and how it can assist in meeting their individual career goals.

The selection team will also consider the geographical location of applicants to ensure representation from across the region.
